Father's Focus

Blessing of Holy Water to be Distributed at Home Visits

On June 3rd parishioners attended the first training session for doing home visits. At that session I blessed the Holy Water that is going to be sent to every home. Some members of the team thought you should hear the prayer of blessing over the water. So this Father's Focus is written for you to know what words were used in the blessing of Holy Water that you can use to bless your homes.

Prayer of Blessing By Fr. Jarrod Lies, Pastor of St Francis of Assisi, Wichita, KS

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Good and gracious God, you have given us the sign of water to remind us of the purity of Baptism. When you were among us as a man, you yourself purified the waters by being baptized in the Jordan. When you went into the Jordan, you sanctified the waters for all time and gave the water the power to restore us to life in your name. Through Faith, you have given us this gift of Baptism to purify us of sin, to make us children of the Father, brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ, and temples of the Holy Spirit. May this water be a symbol of our connection to the St. Francis Parish Family.

Wherever this water is sprinkled, we ask that you drive out the power of Satan. Give this water the unique power to purify homes, to uplift hearts, to reconcile families, to give a new hope and to enlighten people with the gifts of Faith, Hope and Charity. As this water is sprinkled in homes, allow it to call forth the presence of our Guardian Angels who, like sentinels, give protection to our houses from all that can cause harm. May this holy water protect all that it touches from any physical harm. May it keep at bay any tornadoes, earthquakes, fire or any other natural disasters. May this Holy Water give us confidence, Lord Jesus Christ, that you are God of Heaven and Earth.

And, Jesus, as you stilled the waters of the world when you were in a boat, we ask that this Holy Water now also bring peace and calm upon all that it is sprinkled upon. We give you thanks in what you have done in saving our souls. You have saved us through the Birth of Baptism by the waters of Life. We ask that these be reminders of that same birth.

So now God, we call down your blessing upon this Holy Water. Make it sanctified by your presence. As you plunged yourself into the waters of the Jordan, so now plunge yourself into these waters so that they may be sanctified by your power.

And may Almighty God bless this water in the name of the Father, and of the Son and the Holy Spirit.

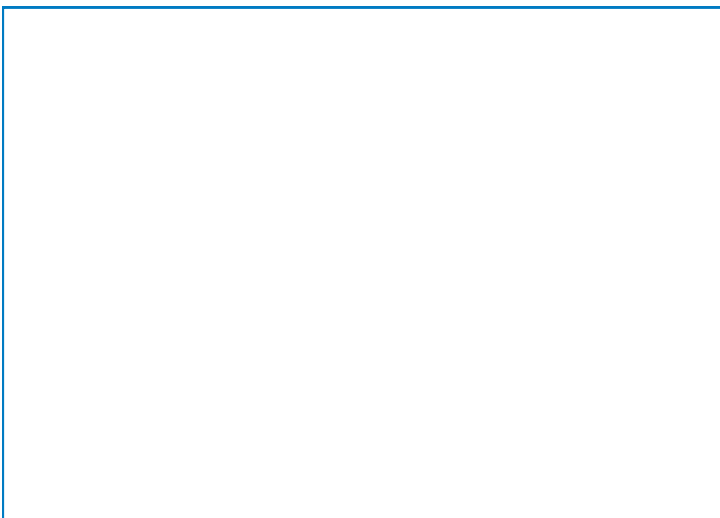
