### Trust Fall

I've never done a "trust fall." That's one of those community building activities where one person stands behind another person. The person in front closes his or her eyes, holds his or her arms out, and then, stiff as a plank, falls straight backwards. The person standing behind, then catches the first under their arms. The trust is in the act of falling; knowing that the other person won't let them fall. Now, like I've said, I've never done a trust fall; not because I wouldn't. I just haven't had the occasion to do one. (Actually, at my present "girth" I would wonder who would want to attempt to catch me!)

But I should really say that I haven't done one of *those* trust falls. I have, however, done THE 'trust fall' of faith. Like Indiana Jones in *Raiders of the Lost Ark*, faith is like standing at the edge of a ravine, seemingly endless in depth, sticking out your foot and... falling. And, again like Indiana Jones, learning that there was solid ground there all along. The solid ground is God himself.

God has begged for us to trust him again, and again, and again. One psalm says, "God is, for us, a refuge and strength... supreme among the nations, supreme on the earth (Ps 46:1, 10)." And yet again another says, "If God is for us, who can be against us (Rom 8:31)?" The message is clear: trust God. Do not be afraid. God is for us.

It is exactly this kind of trust fall that we need when sharing the stewardship of our treasure. In fact St. Paul, when he was encouraging the Corinthians to be "cheerful givers (2 Cor 9:6)," repeated the message of trust four times! He said:

1. He who sows bountifully will reap bountifully (2 Cor. 9:5).
2. God is able to provide you with every blessing abundantly (2 Cor. 9:6).
3. He will supply and multiply your resources (2 Cor. 9:10).
4. You will be enriched in every way for great generosity (2 Cor. 9:11).

Brothers and Sisters, my focus for this week is simply this: trust God with your financial life. An aspect of that financial life is your tithe – 8% to the parish and 2% to charities. I know many of you have seen that we are nearly \$400,000 behind our budget. This time last year we just "slid into home plate" having all of our bills paid. This year, that is not the case.

If you have had difficulty in offering your stewardship of treasure over the past year, or if you are behind on your pledge, could you consider sacrificially giving this summer as a sheer act of trust to God? God's promise is absolutely clear: he will bless you with abundance, he will multiply your resources, he will enrich your life.

Yes, it feels like a trust fall. Yes, it feels like dangling one foot over a big cavern that seems bottomless. But know this – your trust in God will always be met with his blessing.

### "STEWARDED OUR GIFTS: GO IN PEACE, GLORIFYING THE LORD BY YOUR LIFE"

Someone recently asked, "If you were put on trial for being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict you?" This question causes us to reflect on our behaviors, and to consider how many of those behaviors would be considered Christian. In today's readings, there is a theme of sin and its dark effects. The gospel reminds us that, "Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known." It sounds like Jesus is telling us not to behave in a manner that we would not want revealed. Instead, behave in a way that would certainly find us guilty of being a Christian! We should proclaim our faith in Jesus, share His teachings with those we encounter, and not be afraid to stand up for our belief. We can find consolation in the words of the prophet, Jeremiah: "But the LORD is with me, like a mighty champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph." Do not be afraid to dedicate your life to the glorification of the Lord!
